| 7 | Past Business: (NOM) <br> - Jeremy K. : Add a Basketball playoff format in the LSAA constitution <br> - Addition of draw would be added to constitution as a reference for event coordinator/host. <br> - We do still have some issues at the Ward level because the number of teams vary. <br> - Dustin will draw up a proposed Draft and present to members at the September 2022 meeting. |
| 8 | New Business: <br> - School Mascots and Colors (Dustin) <br> - Principals from Voyageur and CLJH have to an agreement for their school Mascots. Voyageur will stay the Vipers and CLJH will be the Cobras. Colors and mascots will be updated in LSAA constitution. <br> - North Star are Polar Bears with Yellow/Blue as school colors. <br> - Starting blocks for sprints (Dustin) <br> - Schools should try to teach on how to use starting blocks in grades 8 or 9 . Purchasing one set for the school would make a huge difference when those students register for sprint events at track and field. <br> - If we decide as an association that the grade 9's should use Starting Blocks, all Seniors should use them at starting line. It should not be a choice to use them or not. <br> - Andrew will draft a NOM for the September meeting. <br> - Hurdles at Track and Field (Dustin): see new Notice of Motions section <br> - Incident at East track (Dustin): Following an incident at the East Ward Track and Field Event, representatives had a chance to discuss and set pro-active solutions for future events. |

- Possibility that the 400 and 800 could not be back to back as sometimes those individuals run the same race. (Andrew)
- Discussion was to see if this would be possible but by doing so would create other issues to the schedule. Further discussions and options will be looked at. We could also look at the NEASAA schedule but schools have to keep in mind that changing the schedule could lengthen the day.
- Badminton districts especially how to fill out scorecards (Andrew)
- Steven has supplied the Scorecard that will be added to LSAA website in Resources section. We encourage schools to teach students on how to properly use a scoresheet and how to read a tournament bracket draw.
- Non Active Member School - Removal?
- Dustin will contact the School Principals prior to our September meeting to ask if they wish to stay with our association. If so, they will need to send a representative to meetings.
- Add North Star Elementary to Association. (Cindy)
- North Star Elementary was voted in as an active member of the LSAA (Proposed by Paul, seconded by Brandon, vote: all in favor - passed)
- No Cash to be handed in to treasurer. Only cheques. (Proposed by Brandon, seconded by Patrick, vote: all in favor - passed )


## New Notice of Motions: (To be voted at the September 2022 meeting)

1. Schools that are not represented at LSAA meeting will be fined $100 \$$ (Andrew)
2. For the upcoming track season tyro and novice will no longer have hurdles as an event. (Andrew)
3. For the upcoming track season Jr, Int and Sr boys and girls will have the same hurdle height set at 27 inches. (Andrew)
4. For the upcoming track season tyro and novice triple jump event will be switched to a standing broad jump. (Andrew)
5. For the upcoming track season boys and girls senior category will use starting blocks for all track events. (Andrew)
6. Badminton: Remove scorekeepers for NOVICE categories in LSAA Constitution (Andrew)
7. Badminton: Tie-Breaker procedures for a 3 way tie. (Andrew)
8. Badminton: Add - Coaches can have a 1 minute discussion with their athletes between 2 badminton sets. (Andrew)
9. Separate the Ward Badminton and Track \& Field competitions into two different events: "Tyro/Novice" and "Junior/Intermediate/Senior". Schools would be permitted to register up to 4 entries per category. (Steven R)

Rational:

- Participation is one of the LSAA's major objectives - this would permit more students the opportunity to compete in their Ward Playoff.
- By separating into 2 events we can accommodate larger registration numbers (increasing from 2 to 4 ).
- This would permit Wards to be held on 2 separate days.
- Additionally, we are exploring the idea of modifications to events offered at the Tyro/Novice level (separate motion to be voted on in Sept) which would streamline the events offered at each age-level event.

a) Badminton

Event coordinators mention that all competitions went very well. Some categories are unfortunately under represented. Some concerns brought forward about next year's NLSD reconfigurations and that only 2 athletes can be registered. With some of the larger schools, this creates an unfortunate situation that very few students will have access to Jr High LSAA competitions. This also carried over to Track and Field.

Meet managers were very satisfied with the season and Notice of Motions are done to accommodate more participation in the upcoming years.

Schools also need to send more student supervisors if they are running an event. When running an event (Ex: discus throw), this is an all day responsibility. Please staff accordingly to supervise and run your events.

Have a podium available at each ward would be a great addition when hosting events. Parents, staff and student really appreciate have a podium for 3 finishers. Paul will look into building 3 sets for next year.
