| 7 | New Business: <br> A) New Cold Lake School Configurations and how it will affect LSAA (Dustin) requested by Chan C. <br> Members had a good discussion about the new school configurations from Cold Lake (Public System) for next year and the impact it has with our association. <br> Cold Lake High School : Grades 10 to 12 <br> Cold Lake Middle School: Grades 7 to 9 <br> NHS: Grades 4 to 6 <br> Estimates are that there will be about 170 grade 9's.
