7 New Business:

A) New Cold Lake School Configurations and how it will affect LSAA (Dustin) requested by Chan C.

Members had a good discussion about the new school configurations from Cold Lake (Public System) for next year and the impact it has with our association.

Cold Lake High School: Grades 10 to 12 Cold Lake Middle School: Grades 7 to 9

NHS: Grades 4 to 6

Estimates are that there will be about 170 grade 9's. Because of this, would the grade 9 students be competitive in JV as they could not be teamed up with grade 10 students?

For the moment, no changes are needed for LSAA because of this but we will always keep an open discussion if the need arises.

Here are some other discussion points that were brought up:

- In league play, there is usually no team limitations
- For wards and districts, we will not be able to change anything
- Some students (because of numbers) are already getting cut
- Gym time and coaches are often an issue if you have more teams
- Schools will have to send their A team (or players) to wards.

B) Basketball Format for wards and districts - (Wayne)

- It was very difficult to get referees for Wards and district competition.
- We need to add a district playoff format in LSAA constitution (Jason K. will submit a draft)

- C) Plaques and medals purchases (Mitchel)
- Mitchel will order all medals, ribbons and plaques in the summer and hand them out to event coordinators at the September meeting of each year.
- Cost of Plaques will be covered by the Association. We will no longer ask 40\$ to the host.
- Sportsmanship pins (usually 4) will be handed out to Hosts prior to events. Host coordinators will be able to hand them out at the event. We ask that host schools do a write-up for those who received the pins. Please send write-up to LSAA secretary. Name of recipients and write-up will be posted on Website and Social Media. We also ask that coordinators mention the Sportsmanship Pins during the coaches meeting and also mention it in the info package.
