# **New Notice of Motions: (To be voted at the September 2022 meeting)**

- 1. Schools that are not represented at LSAA meeting will be fined 100\$: **Vote: All in favor (carried)**
- 2. For the upcoming track season tyro and novice will <u>no longer have hurdles</u> as an event. **Vote : All in favor (carried)**
- 3. For the upcoming track season Jr, Int and Sr boys and girls will have the same <u>hurdle height set at 27 inches</u>. **Vote : All in favor (carried)**
- 4. For the upcoming track season tyro and novice triple jump event will be switched to a <u>standing broad jump</u>. **Vote** : **23 in favor**, **1 abstained** (carried)
- 5. For the upcoming track season boys and girls senior category will use starting blocks for all track events. **Vote**: **All in favor (carried)**
- 6. Badminton: <u>Remove scorekeepers</u> for NOVICE categories in LSAA Constitution Vote: **All in favor (carried)**
- 7. Badminton: Tie-Breaker procedures for a 3 way tie. Adopt ASAA rules . **All in favor (carried)**
- 8. Badminton: Add Coaches can have a <u>1 minute discussion</u> with their athletes between 2 badminton sets. **All in favor (carried)**
- 9. New WARD Basketball Playoff format: **11 in favor , 0 No, 6 Abs** (carried) New format will be posted on LSAA website in resources
- 10. Amended to separate Badminton and Track and Field to be able to vote NOM separately:
- a) Split the **Ward** Badminton competition into two different events: "Tyro/Novice" and "Junior/Intermediate/Senior". Schools would be permitted to register up to <u>4 entries</u> per category.

Vote: 8 Yes. 6 No, 10 Abstained (Carried)

b) Split the **Ward** Track and Field competition into two different events: "Tyro/Novice" and "Junior/Intermediate/Senior". Schools would be permitted to register up to <u>4 entries</u> per category.

Vote: 5 Yes. 8 No, 9 Abstained (Defeated)

#### Rational:

- Participation is one of the LSAA's major objectives this would permit more students the opportunity to compete in their Ward Playoff.
- By separating into 2 events we can accommodate larger registration numbers (increasing from 2 to 4).
- This would permit Wards to be held on 2 separate days.
- Additionally, we are exploring the idea of modifications to events
  offered at the Tyro/Novice level (separate motion to be voted on in
  Sept) which would streamline the events offered at each age-level
  event.
