Notice of Motion (Dennis): Grade 4's would be allow to play in competitions providing they are of Grade 5 age or with special permission from the executive two weeks prior to the completion date.. (they are needed to make a team for doubles in badminton, extra player for a basketball team...etc,). The school reps would need to demonstrate/provide evidence for the grade 4 to participate. Providing the school has grade 4's in their grade configuration and are members of the association. (This not to be used to have masses of grade 4's participating.) Grade 4's can not replace a grade 5. (Grade 4 can replace a grade 5 if of grade 5 age.)

- Scratch fines have improved the number of players dropping out at the last minute. It was suggested that the Scratch Fine could be added to school permission slips. Parents would be aware of the cost for not showing up to the tournament.
- Change the wording for Point 9 in the constitution:
- "9. Tyro and Novice must use a scoreboard for each court. The team playing next will do the scoring."
